2011 CNOq-TWAS Fellowships Programme

Young scientists from developing countries (other than Brazil) are invited to apply to the 2011 CNPq-TWAS Fellowships programme. The fellowships offered by the CNPq-TWAS Fellowships programme allow scientists from developing countries (other than Brazil) to study or to do research in natural sciences in Brazil and then to return home to continue their careers.

The National Council for Scientific and Technological Development (CNPq), Brasilia, Brazil – www.cnpq.br – is a foundation linked to the Brazilian Ministry of Science and Technology. CNPq is one of the major public institutions supporting science, technology and innovation in Brazil and contributes directly to the training of researchers in the various fields of knowledge. TWAS, the Academy of Sciences for the Developing World – www.twas.org – is an autonomous international organization founded in Trieste, Italy, in 1983. Its principal aim is to promote scientific capacity and excellence for sustainable development in the South.

Types of fellowships and duration:

A. Full-time postgraduate/doctorate fellowships: CNPq-TWAS Postgraduate Fellowships are tenable at research institutions in Brazil for a period of up to 48 months and are awarded to students from developing countries (other than Brazil) to enable them to pursue studies leading towards a PhD degree in natural sciences.

B. Sandwich postgraduate/doctorate fellowships: CNPq-TWAS Sandwich Postgraduate Fellowships are tenable at research institutions in Brazil for a minimum period of 6 months to a maximum period of 12 months, and are awarded to students from developing countries (other than Brazil) to enable them to develop part of their PhD course in the natural sciences in Brazil. Under the *sandwich* programme, applicants *must* be registered for a PhD degree in their home country.

SADCO call for applications to PhD

The newly started project Marie Curie Initial Training Network "Sensitivity Analysis for Deterministic Controller Design" – SADCO (see the WEB site <http://itn-sadco.inria.fr/>), funded by the European Union, offers several very well paid PhD and post-doc positions as well as funding for scientific activities. Good students are encouraged to submit their candidature on several topics related to control theory and games. There is a new call for applications for candidates starting their activity on September-October 2011.

According with the EU rules, the hired person is supposed to spend, within the three years of the position, six months in the "secondment" institution, which is indicated in the call for applications:

The salary for a PhD student, for example, consists of two parts: one is fixed (33,000 Euros per year); whereas the other is automatically computed according to some parameters (country, age, status...). The total amount should be in average at

least 40,000 Euros per year, before taxes.

The project may focus on software implementation (under our existing Matlab Toolbox GloptiPoly for solving generalized problems of moments), transfer of knowledge to the French aerospace industry (contracts with EADS Astrium and the French space agency CNES), or more fundamental research activities covering real algebraic geometry (polynomial equations and inequalities), functional analysis (theory of moments), mathematical programming (convex optimization over the cone of positive semidefinite matrices), and nonlinear dynamical systems control.
