We are seeking candidates for a one-year post-doctoral position at LAAS-CNRS, University of Toulouse, France, within an ongoing project focusing on semidefinite programming and algebraic geometry for polynomial optimal control. The project may focus on software implementation (under our existing Matlab Toolbox GloptiPoly for solving generalized problems of
